

Paul Carlin Outstanding Leadership Award, 2021/22

Seeking Nominations

The Rotary Club of Carlton is seeking nominations for the Paul Carlin Outstanding Leadership Award. Introduced in 2010, this Award recognises an individual who has made a significant contribution through outstanding leadership to the Carlton precinct, and, in particular, it's "Caring for Carlton" Community Program. Paul's insight and vision has engaged and inspired people around him. These qualities further demonstrate the core values of Rotary International namely: Service, Fellowship, Diversity, Integrity and Leadership.

Paul Carlin

Paul Carlin joined the Rotary Club of Carlton in 2002 and demonstrated outstanding leadership across a wide range of portfolios over 15 years of dedicated service. His commitment, dedication, loyalty and positivity was respected by all Rotarians both at Club and District 9800 level, as well as his network of friends that he influenced and nurtured. Paul was a Past President of Carlton Rotary (2009 - 2010) and in 2015 he received a Paul Harris Fellowship for outstanding service to Rotary. The Rotary Club of Carlton Outstanding Leadership Award was re-named in Paul's honour following his untimely passing in 2017.

Selection Criteria

Nominations are sought that address the following selection criteria:

Essential

- Displayed positive leadership
- Performed in a spirit of service before self
- Involvement in activities which have benefitted the local community of the Rotary Club of Carlton. (This includes the Cluster Clubs of Collingwood, Fitzroy, Richmond and Melbourne Park).

Desirable

- Undertaken work in a community setting
- People whose service has not been otherwise acknowledged are encouraged to nominate for this Award.

Note: Rotarians are ineligible to nominate for this Award

The successful nominee(s) will attend a meeting of the Rotary Club of Carlton to receive the Award.

At this meeting, the awardee(s) will present a 15-minute presentation about their work. The \$1,000 monetary award is to be allocated to further their agency's community activities.

Submitting a Nomination

- Each of the above selection criteria must be addressed.
- Nominations must be received by 5pm, 30 May 2022.
- You cannot nominate yourself. (If you are nominating someone else, please seek their permission first).
- Nominations require a high quality personal photograph.
- This photo may be used on the Rotary Club of Carlton's website and social media pages, newsletter, in print and in other promotions. By submitting a photo, you are acknowledging that the Rotary Club of Carlton may use them in the public domain.
- Nominations can have attached supporting documents.

How will the nominations be assessed?

Members of the Board of the Rotary Club of Carlton will assess the nominations. The judging panel may, at its discretion, request to visit or speak to nominees.
